


**UAW LOCAL 218**  
**2010-2011**  
**HIRAM A. MOON SCHOLARSHIP**

1. You must have at least a “C” average to be eligible for this scholarship, and must maintain a “C” average to be eligible for the second semester tuition scholarship. A second transcript must be provided to prove “C” average for second semester funds.
2. One of your parents or grandparents must be a member, or retired member in good standing of UAW Local 218.
3. UAW Local 218’s Financial Secretary will certify the Application.
4. Amount of scholarship is \$500 (\$250.00 each semester, with receipts)
5. The scholarship is for continuing education only. It may not be used for education on the high school level. This scholarship may be used at any college, university, or continuing education trade school, regardless of their location.
6. Scholarships will be awarded by a random drawing on **Sunday, September 19th** at the regular UAW 218 membership meeting. In order for an applicant to qualify for the drawing, the applicant must be approved by the Executive Board. Approval is based on an applicant meeting stated eligibility requirements and deadlines.
7. UAW Local 218 will sponsor up to Five (5) \$500.00 scholarships per year.
8. The scholarship money will be awarded upon proof of enrollment to the Financial Secretary with approval from the UAW Local 218 Executive Board and Local Union membership vote. The scholarship recipients will be reimbursed for actual expenses (receipts required), not to exceed \$250 per semester.
